

Spring Pruning provides many benefits for you and your landscape. The most important benefit our clients share with us about the pruning service we provide is how beautiful and natural the plants look when we're finished. One of the reasons that Tomlinson Bomberger was voted #1 Tree Service by the readers of Lancaster County Magazine is that they appreciate the aesthetic appearance of properly pruned trees and shrubs. We have been promoting thinning & selective pruning (instead of shearing) as the arboriculturally correct practice for trees and shrubs. All plants have a natural growth habit that we prefer to promote with the style of pruning that we utilize. Our Certified Arborists (we have twelve) have been trained and tested to affirm their proficiency in maintaining plants that are attractive and healthy.

Shearing plants should be limited to hedge type plantings whose purpose is to formally frame a garden area or to screen off the visibility of your home from roadways or from adjoining properties.

The health of your trees & shrubs depends on many things, with the most

important being regular inspections by qualified professionals. The things that affect plants fall into two basic groups: **biotic** (living) and **abiotic** (environmental or cultural) influences. Here are some of the challenges that our arborists find on a regular basis:

#### **BIOTIC FACTORS**

Insects • Mites • Diseases

#### **ABIOTIC FACTORS**

- Improper pruning
- Too much mulch
- Mower damage
- Girdling roots
- Nutrient imbalance
- Watering (insufficient or too much)
- Drought stress
- Wind or storm damage
