EASTERN TENT CATERPILLAR

This spring pest constructs **silken nests or tents** in the crotches or forks of trees branches. During this life stage, the larvae grow to about two inches long and are generally black with a white stripe down the center of the back with some bright blue spots along the sides. You can find them most often on Cherry, Crabapple, and Apple trees, and occasionally on other deciduous ornamental shrubs and shade trees.



- Incorporate organic matter and aerate the soil to encourage root development
- Prepare the planting site. Dig only as deep as the root ball requires and dig at least twice the width
- Remove all plastic, wire cages, twine, and burlap that impede root growth
- Cover the site with mulch two inches deep, but be sure to keep mulch away from the stem

Watering, fertilizing, pruning, mulching, treating weeds, sanitation and pest control are cultural practices that have significant impact on plant health. The value of a **PHC** program is obtained through regular monitoring, preventive treatments, better timing of corrective remedies, proper pesticide use and other biological controls.
