Mild Winter =


The mild Winter we experienced this year favors the survival of several landscape pests. Insects, for example, are able to survive Winters when there aren't large extremes in temperatures. Similarly, weather conditions during the growing season will play a major role in the insect populations in your landscape. Many insects thrive in warm, dry weather.

The lack of an extremely cold Winter also means warmer soil temperatures that could result in early infestations of weeds in the Springtime. As soil temperatures increase over the Spring

and lawns green up and begin to grow, so do weed populations. When soil temperatures reach 55 degrees, crabgrass begins to germinate.


